



LIFELINE Discussion Guide

Week of October 27, 2025

1. What was your response to the assassination of Charlie Kirk at a university event in Utah? How do you feel about it now? Why do you think there has been a nationwide response to this event— both politically and spiritually? Have you had any conversations with anyone about this topic? What was talked about? Was the person open to spiritual things?
2. Do you have to be a pastor, missionary, or Bible College graduate to speak truth about the most challenging issues of human life? Discuss your answer and be sure to include 1 Peter 3:15.
3. While the Bible is filled with many insights and profound truths, Pastor Ryan suggested that today's Christians be prepared to share **LIFE'S MOST IMPORTANT TRUTHS** with anyone who is searching.

Read aloud the verses associated with each statement below, then discuss how you would share this truth in a practical way with a person who isn't a Christian but is desperately searching for answers:

a. THAT GOD IS: (The existence of God)

Genesis 1:1; Psalm 19:1-4; Romans 1:20; Hebrews 11:6

What examples from creation or nature could you use to demonstrate the existence of God?

b. WHO GOD IS: (The nature and character of the one, true God)

Isaiah 46:9-10; Jeremiah 9:24; Leviticus 19:2; Psalm 145:8-9

God isn't a cosmic force or some impersonal power. What personal attributes does He possess? How could you help someone understand that biblical faith isn't about religious rules to uphold, but a relationship with God to experience and enjoy? How would you describe your relationship with God to someone who was searching?

c. WHAT GOD DID: (The saving work of God for sinners)

John 3:16-17; 1 Corinthians 15:1-4; Romans 5:1-2; 6:23; 1 John 5:11-12

Why is the gospel 'good news' for all people everywhere? How would you explain the gospel plainly in your own words, without confusing the person with "religious jargon"?

4. Close your LifeGroup with a time of group prayer, asking God to open doors for gospel conversations both **NATIONALLY** and **PERSONALLY**, and that the Holy Spirit would help you speak courageously and clearly for Jesus and the gospel.
